_____ Pasteurizing milk/Lab support - Work in teams; defrosted milk is pooled, mixed, poured into glass bottles and pasteurized; involves standing for up to 3 hours and lifting flasks full of milk. HOURS: Needs vary by day of the week. Check with communications & volunteer coordinator. We ask that you come in for a shift of 2-3 hours at a time.

_____ --Milk logging: Assist with entering tracking information on donor milk into our data management system. HOURS: Any Monday through Friday, 9am-5pm. We ask that you come in for a shift of 2-3 hours at a time.

_____ Office Helper --Assist with phone calls, data entry, photocopying, correspondence, filing, log milk, etc. HOURS: Any Monday through Friday, 9am-5pm.

_____ Donor milk transporter in Austin and surrounding area--Deliver milk to hospital nurseries, pick up milk from donor mothers and local milk depots; requires some lifting of coolers full of milk.

_____ Donor milk transporter for Houston, Waco, Corpus Christi and San Antonio etc.-- pick up milk from Milk Depots or out of town donor mothers; may be done any day of the week in conjunction with a visit or business trip, but milk must be delivered promptly to the Austin milk bank; requires some lifting; weekly, bi-weekly and monthly opportunities
